

Carnaby's Black Cockatoo - A cross regional extension project

Project Description

The current cross-regional Carnaby's Black-Cockatoo Recovery Project was due for completion in October 2007 (although, due to project staff turnover, an extension till 30 June 2008 has been granted to finalise some of the milestones). This has been a very successful project with numerous on-ground outputs achieved in the Northern Agricultural Region

Additional activities funded until 31 December 2008 include:

- Continued employment of the Regional Coordinator including administration fees and on costs.
- Review of five years of monitoring data in the Avon Wheatbelt and re-invigoration of monitoring program in light of the review
- Continued monitoring breeding pairs in priority areas across the species' range.
- Facilitation of on-ground recovery actions to protect existing key feeding and breeding habitat.
- Facilitation of on-ground recovery actions to increase the extent of key feeding and breeding habitat in priority areas.
- Engaging of community members across the species' range to undertake monitoring and on-ground recovery actions.
- Review of the projects' outcomes against priority actions in the Recovery Plan, and planning for future high-priority recovery actions for Carnaby's Black-Cockatoo
