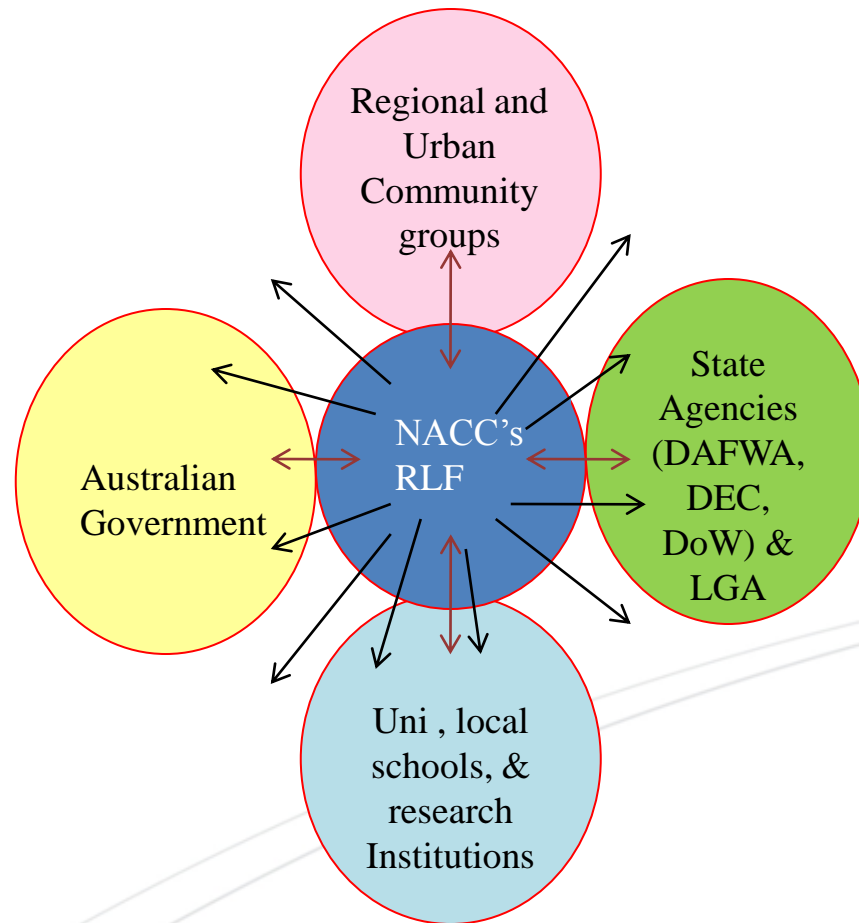

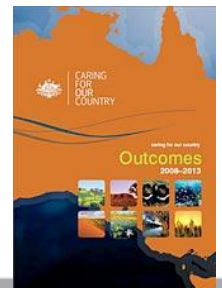
A summary of the RLF in the NAR



Key objectives of the RLF



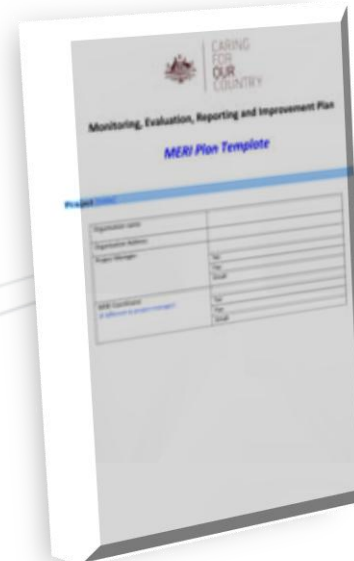
- Promote uptake of sustainable farm and land management practices in region.
- Provide an effective interface between the regional NRM bodies and community Landcare and production groups.
- Promote opportunities for groups and networks to access public and private funds to undertake Landcare/NRM projects
- Facilitate effective community feedback to the Australian Government
- Communicate relevant AG policy and program to stakeholders
- Contribute to the five CFOC sustainable farming outcomes as identifies in the 2008-2013 outcomes statement



What have been achieved so far
