* New walk trails to remain as informal sand paths with interpretive and directional signage at entrances to track and along the route. Potential upgrade of surface in future.

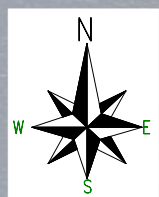
* This site is within a designated aboriginal heritage area.
