Can we use coding for good?

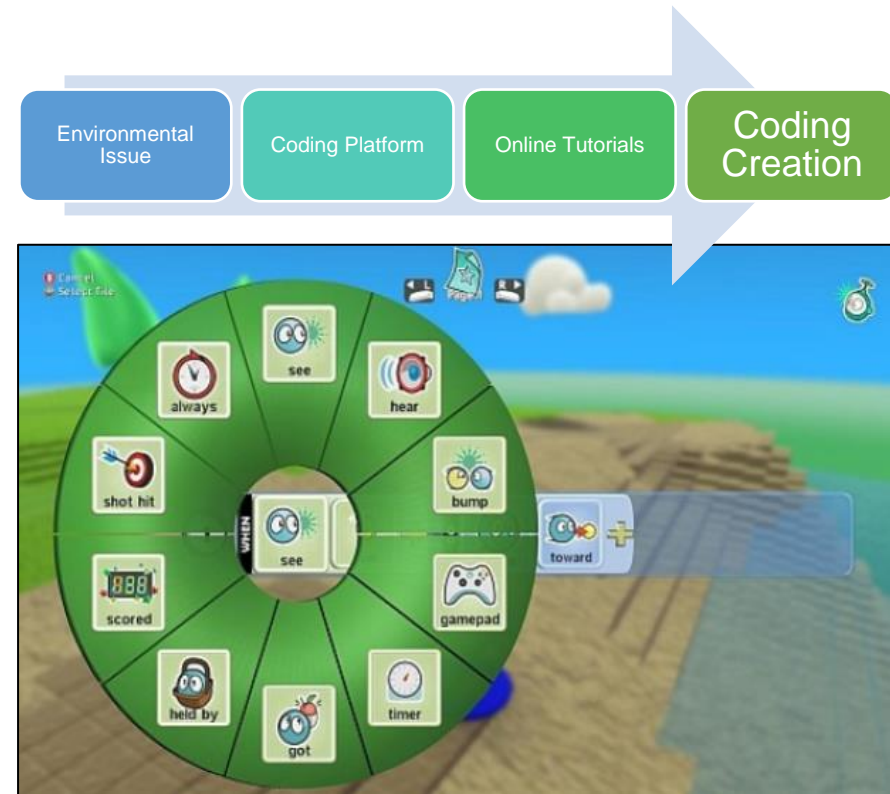
The Western Australian coastal environments need our support. Issues include habitat destruction, pollution, salinity, introduced species, climate change and many more.
